

# PROPOSED CHICKEN NAE METHODOLOGY CHANGE NOTICE

The following will be added to the NAE Pricing Table:

NAE Fresh Chicken Leg Meat 4/10's, boneless/skinless	The proposed item has become sufficiently traded to allow the poultry reporting team to initiate this coverage, while maintaining the rigorous reporting standards mandated by Urner Barry's Reporting Methodology.

In addition, Urner Barry will now be providing market assessments for all quoted NAE lines **5 days a week, Monday through Friday**. Moving forward, Urner Barry's reporting office is committed to maintaining the rigorous standards mandated by Urner Barry's Reporting Methodology, as well as refining and growing the initiative to better align with stakeholders' needs.

Following the review period, the Urner Barry NAE Chicken Market Methodology document will be updated to include the changes.
